



**Route 29 and Route 699 (Gladys Rd.)
Campbell County
Intersection Improvement Project**

Find out about the proposed improvements for the section of Route 29 that starts 0.092 mile south of Route 699 and ends 0.541 mile north of Route 699 in Campbell County. The purpose of this project is to improve safety at the US 29 and Route 699 Intersection by constructing raised islands to create an RCUT (Restricted Crossing U-Turn). This will restrict Route 699 traffic from turning left to head southbound on Route 29 and require a U-turning movement at the cross-over north of the intersection to go south. Route 29 southbound traffic will still be able to turn left onto Route 699.

Review the proposed project plans and the National Environmental Policy Act documentation in the form of a Programmatic Categorical Exclusion at the public hearing or at VDOT's Lynchburg District Office located at 4219 Campbell Avenue in Lynchburg. Property impact information, relocation assistance policies and tentative construction schedules are available for your review at the above address and will be available at the public hearing.

In compliance with the National Historic Preservation Act, Section 106 and 36 CFR Part 800, information concerning the potential effects of the proposed improvements on properties listed in or eligible for listing in the National Register of Historic Places is also available for public review.
